1 ARCHITECTURE

See the big picture, but make the details work. We are in this for the long haul

2 SCOPE MANAGEMENT

A Quick Start or Proof of Concept is often the best way to control scope and budget, but still satisfy the skeptics - then do the phased project. Will it scale?

4 SUPPORT

How did we get here?

No matter how good the intentions are, different organizations often head in different directions. Sometimes this can even happen in parts of the same organization.

So what does this mean in the world of Identity and Access Management (IAM)? The answer can be anything from 'no problem' to 'we are doomed'.

In the end, it is all 1's and 0's - it can be done, but it needs the right approach, the right experience and the right tools.

Some of the core concepts are:

- ◆ Architecture - yes, we can do this
- ◆ Scope Control - no, not all of it
- ◆ Integration - so do it
- ◆ Support - now what

By careful selection of business goals, the appropriate integrations can be designed and implemented. This often takes time (usually because of political or organizational issues), but the technical challenges are surmountable.

- ◆ Active Directory
- ◆ LDAP, SQL
- ◆ <that homegrown system>

At the core though, they are all dealing with identities, accounts, passwords, systems and privileges. Data mapping can be tedious, but is more often tripped up by carelessness than by complexity.

There are many solutions available, and many can be implemented in a surprisingly short time frame.
